

POSADA *of the* MIGRANT

December 18 | 3-6 pm | Nogales, MX

You are invited to walk with Jesus, Mary, and Joseph as we remember and pray for immigrants who must leave their homeland in search for a better life. The annual *Posada of the Migrant* will take place on December 18, 2010 on the Mexican side of the Mariposa Port of Entry in Nogales, Sonora, MX. The Posada will begin at 3 p.m. Following the Posada there will be a festive dinner at the Kino Border Initiative Migrant Comedor. You will be led directly from the Posada to the Comedor.

Directions:

Take I-19 to Nogales, Arizona and take exit 4 (Hwy 189). Make a right at the exit and travel toward Mexico until you see a Shell gas station on the left side of the Road. Directly across from the Shell station is the Econo Gas Station. You will park there for \$5. You will then be directed to the Port of entry by Franciscans and Volunteers. They will have signs saying 'Posada of the Migrant'.

Wear casual clothes and shoes. The Posada procession is around 1 mile, including the short walk after the posada to the Comedor.

You need a **passport** to re-enter the USA.
